Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (Chesapeake) has requested confidential classification of certain information provided in Exhibit A to Amendment No. 2 to the Gas Transportation Service Special Contract (page 4); in the petition, identified at page 3, paragraph 7; as well as in the Cost of Service Study attached to the petition, on the sheet identified as "Calculation of Other Taxes," in the line "Estimated Sales Revenue." Chesapeake asserts that this information meets the definition of "proprietary confidential business information" as set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.

Staff has reviewed the document and agrees with Chesapeake that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., whereby disclosure of the information would be harmful to Chesapeake's competitive business operations. Therefore, staff recommends that Chesapeake's request for confidential classification of Document No. 04863-15 be approved.
