Our main meter is running way to fast and need to be repaired or replaced.

After the person from FWRA he has the hooked up his on devise to our output, for a period of time it become more obvious.

He could not measure the true extent of the uncounted gallons shown in our records, but according to his experience it must be substantial.

He will be back to conduct more test regarding where the water actually flows after we have taken care of our meter.
