MR. ROME: Good morning. Don Rome with Commission staff.

Item 11 is a petition by Tampa Electric Company for approval of the phased closure by July 2016 of its residential load management program, commonly known as Prime Time. The Commission recognized Prime Time as not being cost-effective in 2005, and the program has been closed to new customers since that time.

Based on staff's review of the petition and other support documentation provided in response to staff's data request, staff believes that TECO's request for the phased closure of the Prime Time program is reasonable. The program continues to not be cost-effective; therefore, nonparticipating customers pay a subsidy to program participants. There also are significant technical and logistical impediments to continued operation of the program.

Staff recommends approval.

**CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Any questions of staff? Commissioner Brown.

**COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Yes. This was a good program. It's sad to see it go, but it was

**COMMISSIONER BROWN:** How will they be notified of -- of the closure?

MR. ROME: The program that the company used and has been explained to us as to how the customers will be notified will consist of a letter to the customers, first of all, notifying them that the program for them will be terminated and that they will no longer receive the credits. Included with that also will be information on potential demand-side management programs that are available to customers. And they also will be given direct lines to energy management services staff so that customers, if they have questions, can contact people who are very well informed and able to address customers' questions and their specific needs.

**COMMISSIONER BROWN:** Thank you, Don. What would be a comparable DSM program in lieu of this?

**MR. ROME:** The alternative that the company is transitioning to and has had success
