To whom it may concern,

I have just recently learned that Utilities Inc. of Florida has a request before your commission to allow their average customer monthly sewer charge to be increased from \$62.29/month to \$148.87/month. I find this request to include price gouging and to be an excessive burden for the people. This equates to WELL OVER 100% increase /month.

I am a retired person living on a fixed income. I own a condo at 8407 Placida Rd unit 401, Cape Haze, Fl. This unit will only be used for less than 1/2 of the year.

Yet, with this request, my condo fee will increase more than \$600 annually should you agree with this request.

I am currently paying \$24/month for my residence in MI. 49071 and ZERO \$ in the winter months as they allow my service to be suspended while I am not there.

Utilities Inc. of Sandalhaven has made an investment which failed to work out and therefore, should be merged with a larger Charlotte County Sewer Authority. I am asking that you NOT grant this request to increase these fees thereby placing an undue burden on the people.
