Please respond to the following questions by September 29 in order for staff to assist in this case in a timely manner.

1. In your meter replacement program as part of the remedial plan submitted to the Southwest Florida Water Management District in September 2014, you proposed an expedited program to replace 12 meters a month for 18

months and a normal annual replacement afterwards. Please provide the estimated number of meters and documentation for the associated expenses annually for the normal replacement program. As part of the response, please provide the number of meters and the fully itemized invoices for meters that you have replaced to date; and an updated costs for the expedited program based on the installed experience.

2. Please provide invoices not yet submitted for all completed Pro Forma items. Please note that items without invoices will be included for Phase II revenues.
