FPUC has appropriately calculated its true-up amounts and purchased gas adjustment factor as shown in the Company's positions on Issues 1-5.

D. - F. Issues

FPUC's positions on the issues identified by Staff are as follows:

<u>Issue 1:</u> What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2014 through December 2014?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$680,691, inclusive of interest.

Issue 2: What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for

the period January 2015 through December 2015?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$932,608, inclusive of interest.

<u>Issue 3:</u> What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected

(refunded) during the period January 2016 through December 2016?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$1,613,299 to be refunded.

Issue 4: What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the

period January 2016 through December 2016?

FPUC: The appropriate PGA factor is 96.810 cents per therm.

Issue 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment

charge for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1,

2016 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between

January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016.

ISSUE 6: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the new purchased

gas adjustment charges determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

<u>FPUC:</u> Agree with Commission Staff.

G. Stipulated Issues

While not a party to stipulations at this time, FPUC believes that it should be possible to reach a stipulation on each of the issues as they pertain to FPUC.
