COMPLAINT INFORMATION

Complaint: Other Complaint against Utilities, Inc. of Longwood

Details:

I recd notice my city wished to raise utility rates. As mine were already far too high, I attended the public meeting where I learned the following:

1. Utilities, Inc., that I pay the high rates to, is not owned by the city; 2. The amount I pay each month is equivalent to the commercial rate of the citys present pricing and is far higher than the citys residential rate; 3. The utilities company has filed its notice to raise rates in Docket # 15005-WS Order #PSC-15-0072-PAA-WS, without w/o public hearing as fl Stat may permit, and; 4. Persons across the State are subject to unconscionable costs due to privately owned utilities companies.

Please make automatic or sweetheart rate increases no longer allowable and make private company rates conform to public company rates, whichever is less painful to current consumers.

You can force sales of property, so force sales of privately owned utilities in the public interest.

I ask whether present or past politicians or lobbyists hold investments in these companies? Can you tell me this? Will you do so?
