BACKGROUND

K W Resort Utilities Corp. (the "Utility") is a wastewater utility whose corporate offices are located at 6630 Front Street, Key West, Florida 33040. The Utility's wastewater facilities are located in Monroe County, Florida.

On July 1, 2015, the Utility filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for an increase in its wastewater rates to its customers in Monroe County based on an historical test year ending December 31, 2014. The application is assigned Docket No. 150071-SU and September 22, 2015 was established as the official date of filing.

The Utility is requesting a rate increase because the existing rates do not provide sufficient revenues to cover the required expenses of operations on a going-forward basis and an opportunity to earn a fair return on the Utility's investment in used and useful property for the public use. The rate of return on equity requested in this proceeding is 9.36%. The overall rate of return requested is 8.01%. The Company's last rate proceeding before the Commission was in Docket No. 070293-SU, utilizing a test year ending December 31, 2006, which culminated in Order No. PSC-09-0057-FOF-SU dated January 27, 2009.

The Utility has incurred substantial additional operating costs and capital investment.
