Docket No. 130209-SU – Application for expansion of certificate (CIAC) (new wastewater line extension charge) by North Peninsula Utilities Corp.

Issue 1: Should North Peninsula Utilities Corporation’s proposed territory amendment be approved?

Recommendation: No. The application fails to demonstrate a need for service in the territory requested. Also, the Utility’s plan to connect customers would require customers to install equipment that is normally the responsibility of the Utility or developer. As such, the requested territory amendment does not appear to be in the public interest and should be denied. The Utility’s existing service availability policy indicates the manner in which service will be provided to vacant lots and the undeveloped eight-acre parcel in its existing territory and should remain unchanged.
