White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc. d/b/a PCS Phosphate–White Springs (“PCS Phosphate”) is providing the following statement in order to facilitate the finalization of the Financing Order that the Commission is scheduled to vote on in these dockets on November 17, 2015.

As an intervenor and active party to the RRSSA and Docket Nos. 150148-EI and 150171-EI, PCS Phosphate has been actively engaged in the exchange among Duke Energy, the Commission Staff, and consumer parties that has sought to reach a consensus concerning final language for a proposed order in these consolidated dockets. PCS has been particularly concerned that the proposed financing order adequately reconcile the express and implied requirements of Section 366.95, Florida Statutes, with the terms for recovering the CR3 asset previously agreed by the parties and approved by the Commission in Order Nos. PSC-13-0598-FOF-EI and 15-0465-S-EI, and has been encouraged that all participants in this process seem to be like-minded in this regard. PCS remains optimistic that all outstanding questions will be resolved prior to the Special Agenda on November 17, and therefore will not file a brief on these matters today, but reserves its rights to verbally address the Commission at its Special Agenda with respect to any unresolved matters or questions the Commission may have.
