

Indication of Underwriting Fee






This letter sets forth the terms and conditions of the engagement of Morgan Stanley & Co. LLC ("Morgan Stanley" or "we") as structuring agent by Duke Energy Florida, Inc. ("DEF," the "Company," or "you") in connection with an anticipated issuance of nuclear asset-recovery bonds up to the amounts approved in a financing order (the "Financing") to be requested from the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC").

During the term of our engagement, we will provide you with assistance in connection with the formulation and implementation of the Financing. Services with respect to the Financing under our engagement include advisory and structuring services such as reviewing of enacted legislation; reviewing Company financing objectives; reviewing rating agency criteria with the Company; developing preliminary financing structures; developing interest rate risk management structures, if applicable; developing the mechanics of properly effecting the Financing, including assistance with preparing billing and collection systems; assistance with preparing related testimony of various Company witnesses; reviewing draft transaction documents; assistance in developing and applying for a proposed financing order and interest rate hedging and regulatory deferral order (if applicable); and providing expert direct testimony and rebuttal testimony (if any).

In connection with the Financing, DEF will pay or cause to be paid to Morgan Stanley, a structuring fee equal to \$400,000 (the "Structuring Fee"). Fifty percent (50%) of the Structuring Fee shall be deemed earned and payable upon the filing by the Company of an application for a financing order with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission"). The remaining fifty percent (50%) of the Structuring Fee shall be earned and payable upon DEF's receipt of credit ratings for the nuclear asset-recovery bonds from at least two rating agencies, however, if such credit ratings have not been received by June 1, 2016, the remaining fifty percent (50%) of the Structuring Fee shall be paid by June 15, 2016. The Structuring Fee shall be payable regardless of whether or not Morgan Stanley acts as an underwriter, placement agent, or initial purchaser of the Financing and regardless of whether or not such payment is reimbursed to the Company as a cost of issuance through any Financing.

AFFIDAVIT OF BRYAN BUCKLER IN SUPPORT OF **DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA'S** REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority duly authorized to administer oaths. personally appeared Bryan Buckler, who being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says that:

- 1. My name is Bryan Buckler. I am over the age of 18 years old and I have been authorized by Duke Energy Florida (hereinafter "DEF" or the "Company") to give this affidavit in the above-styled proceeding on DEF's behalf and in support of DEF's Request for Confidential Classification. The facts attested to in my affidavit are based upon my personal knowledge.
- 2. Effective August 15, 2015, I became the Director of Regulated Accounting for Duke Energy Corporation ("Duke Energy"). In this role I am responsible

for accounting and financial reporting for all of Duke Energy's regulated subsidiaries, including Duke Energy Florida. However, I will still serve as DEF's Treasury witness in this proceeding, and will continue to report to Stephen De May, Senior Vice President and Treasurer of Duke Energy and DEF, for purposes of the nuclear asset-recovery bond transaction.

- 3. DEF is seeking confidential classification for portions of DEF's Response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories, specifically attachments responsive to questions #8 and 34. The confidential information at issue is contained in confidential Exhibit A to this Request and is outlined in DEF's Justification Matrix that is attached to DEF's Request for Confidential Classification as Exhibit C. DEF is requesting confidential classification of this information because it contains sensitive business information, the disclosure of which would impair the Company's efforts to contract for goods and services on favorable terms.
- 4. Attachments to DEF's Response to Staff's 2nd Second Set of Interrogatories, Question #8 (specifically Bates numbers 150148-STAFFROG2-8-000001 through 150148-STAFFROG2-8-000011), and Question #34 (specifically Bates numbers 150148-STAFFROG2-34-000001 through 150148-STAFFROG2-34-00002) contain sensitive business information including Morgan Stanley's engagement letter, underwriting and structuring agent lists provided by Goldman Sachs, and Morgan Stanley's Structuring Advisory Fee Proposal that DEF relied on to analyze historical utility securitization transactions and provide assumptions and justifications for amounts associated with estimated upfront nuclear asset-recovery bond issuance costs and estimated ongoing financing costs. DEF analyzed sensitive business information

provided by Morgan Stanley and Goldman Sachs to support their proposals. In order to obtain such prior utility fee securitization engagement information, however, DEF must be able to assure these competing financial institutions that sensitive business information provided in their proposals, will be kept confidential. With respect to the information at issue in this request, DEF has kept confidential and has not publicly disclosed underwriting fees, advisory fees, and similar competitive information. Absent such measures, financial institutions who otherwise would contract with DEF might decide not to do so if DEF did not keep the terms of their proposals confidential. Without DEF's measures to maintain the confidentiality of sensitive terms in proposals between DEF and third parties, the Company's efforts to obtain competitive prices for its financial needs could be compromised by financial service competitors changing their position or behavior within the relevant markets.

5. Additionally, the above-referenced Bates numbered attachments contain sensitive business information which could adversely impact competitive business interests of financial institutions working with DEF to obtain competitive nuclear asset-recovery bonds for the proposed securitization. DEF has a contractual obligation with these third parties to not disclose the proprietary business information contained in their engagement letters and presentation materials. Absent such confidentiality measures, third party financial advisors would run the risk that sensitive business information that they provided in their discussions with DEF would be made available to the public and, as a result, end up in possession of potential competitors. Faced with that risk, the efforts of financial advisors to competitively negotiate financial alternatives with companies such as DEF could be undermined.

- 6. Upon receipt of confidential information from financial institutions working with DEF, and with its own confidential information, strict procedures are established and followed to maintain the confidentiality of the terms of the documents and information provided, including restricting access to those persons who need the information to assist the Company, and restricting the number of, and access to the information and documents. At no time since receiving the contracts and information in question has the Company publicly disclosed that information or documents. The Company has treated and continues to treat the information and documents at issue as confidential.
 - 7. This concludes my affidavit.
