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## PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item No. 16.

MS. OLLILA: Commissioners, Sue Ollila again for staff. Item 16 is Peoples Gas's annual petition to approve its cast iron/bare steel replacement surcharges for 2016. The proposed surcharge for residential customers is just under two cents per therm resulting in a monthly surcharge of 43 cents for customers who use 20 therms a month. Staff recommends approval, and the Office of Public Counsel is here to speak on this item.

## CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. OPC.

MR. REHWINKEL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. The OPC has concerns about the escalation of costs related to the rider in general. I will say that today we're not here to say that these concerns rise to the level of an objection to what Peoples Gas has filed or the staff's recommendation.

You just heard on the previous item about some concerns we have with respect to the type of costs that are included in another company's similar rider. We are not saying that this issue exists with Peoples Gas, but we are saying that an audit like what the staff did for FPUC/Chesapeake would help. Given that there is an ongoing audit process that has raised concerns with Peoples Gas distribution facilities inspection concerns,

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coupled with the agreement they made last year when we raised the issue about an audit, that they agreed that an audit should be done or could be done, we are here today to renew our request to you that there be an audit of the costs and implementation of the rider and the replacement program that you have before you today.

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We remain supportive of the safety initiative and believe that it is in the public interest and the customers' interest, but we also remain committed to having the company being held accountable for the costs that they recover in this rider.

So our ask for you, and we certainly understand the priority given to FPUC, is that the cost be audited for Peoples Gas in the coming cycle, but we do not object to the approval of the recommendation.

**CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Okay. Staff, comments on the request.

MR. WATSON: Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: I'll be right there.

MR. WATSON: Okay.

MS. OLLILA: Staff is certainly agreeable to an audit.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay.

MS. OLLILA: And we're comfortable with our recommendation, but --

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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Sir.

MR. WATSON: I'm Ansley Watson for Peoples Gas. The company has no objection to the request for an audit.

**CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** Okay. Sounds good to me. Is that like three times in a row that happened?

Commissioner Edgar.

**COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I would move approval of the staff recommendation with further direction to our staff to work with OPC and the company to perform the audit as requested.

**CHAIRMAN GRAHAM:** We have a motion and a second on the floor. Any further discussion? Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.

(Vote taken.)

Any opposed? By your action, you've approved the motion for Item No. 16.
