MR. ROME: Again, good morning. Don Rome with Commission staff.

Item 18 is a petition filed by Peoples Gas

System for approval of tariff modifications to update

its swing service charge based on current cost and

number of customers.

The swing service charge is assessed to Peoples' Natural Choice Transportation Service customers. Updating the cost with providing the system balancing service that the swing service charge is designed to recover ensures an appropriate allocation of costs between transportation service customers and the retail sales customers from whom balancing costs are recovered through the purchase gas adjustment.

Based on a review of the petition and information provided by Peoples in response to staff's data request, staff believes that Peoples' proposed swing service charge tariff modifications are reasonable. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariff modifications to the swing service charge to become effective as of the date of the Commission's vote.

The Office of Public Counsel is here today and

would like to offer remarks on this item as well. 1 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: OPC. 2 3 MS. ROTH: Thank you. For the record, Danielle Roth with the Office of Public Counsel. 4 The OPC intervened to understand and to 5 monitor this tariff that was being handled on an 6 7 expedited basis. Based on the information provided by TECO/Peoples Gas, the swing service modification appears 8 9 rational and more fairly allocates cost among customers. The OPC reserves its judgment and its right to challenge 10 11 the charge if facts turn out to be different than 12 projected in this expedited process. At this time, however, the tariff modification appears to be a 13 14 reasonable modification. Thank you. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Yes, sir. 15 MR. WATSON: No further comments from the 16 17 company. 18 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: You learn very quickly. 19 Commissioners, any comments, concerns, or questions of Item No. 18 from staff or from the company? 2.0 21 Seeing none, I'll entertain a motion. 22 COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Move staff recommendation 23 on all issues. 24 COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Second. 25 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and
