Commissioners, 5 before we start, I would like to introduce a new staff 6 7 member in the Division of Economics. Ms. Sevini Guffey will be introducing the item, and that is her first 8 9 agenda item. And, finally, Duke Energy wants to add a new tariff provision to allow the customers to make an initial Contribution in Aid of Construction payment of 50 percent for certain fixtures and poles. This would help expand payment options available for its customers.

Staff did not receive any customer comments on this proposed petition, and staff has reviewed the documentation and depiction and recommends approval of the proposed tariff revisions. The revised tariff should become effective on January 5th, 2016. And staff is available for any questions.
