REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain information submitted by Gulf Power in response to Commission Staff's Second Data Request to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 1-4) in the above-referenced docket. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

- 1. Information submitted by Gulf Power in response to question number 4 of Commission Staff's Second Data Request constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" as defined pursuant to section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.
- 2. Information submitted in response to question 4 consists of a study titled Economic and Normal Useful Life Study of Solar Project. The study was commissioned by Gulf's affiliate, Southern Company Service, Inc. ("SCS"), and performed by KPMG, LLP. The purpose of the study is to assist Gulf and its affiliates in internal planning and compliance with future financial reporting, tax compliance and regulatory requirements. This information is subject to non-disclosure obligations and is regarded by Gulf, SCS and KPMG as proprietary information. Public disclosure of this information would enable others in the market place to capitalize on this data without compensating the consultant for the same and could result in consultants charging higher prices, or refusing to do business with Gulf, out of concern that their analyses would be publicly disclosed. Public disclosure of this data would impair the

competitive business interests of Gulf Power and its consultant and is therefore entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

- 3. The information filed pursuant to this Request is intended to be, and is treated as, confidential by Gulf Power and, to this attorney's knowledge, has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.
- 4. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a copy of Gulf Power's response to question 4. Exhibit "A" should be treated as confidential in its entirety pending a ruling on this request. . Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a public version of Gulf's response to question 4 which may be made available for public review and inspection. Attached hereto as Exhibit "C" is a justification for confidential treatment of the Confidential Information.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order protecting the information contained within Exhibit "A" from public disclosure as proprietary confidential business information.
