CUSTOMER NOTICE

FEBRUARY 5, 2016

On July 6, 2015, Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven n/k/a Utilities, Inc. of Florida (the "Utility"), completed its application to the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for increased wastewater rates, in which it requested a permanent revenue increase of approximately 137.9% for wastewater service.

By Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-16-0013-PAA-SU ("PAA Order"), issued January 6, 2016, in Docket No. 150102-SU, the Commission proposed a revenue increase of 84.53% for wastewater service. These increases were designed to allow the Utility the opportunity to recover its reasonable and prudent costs for providing service, and a reasonable rate of return on its investment in facilities necessary to provide such wastewater service. The Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") has protested the PAA Order, and pursuant to law the Utility may implement its requested rate increase during the pendency of the protest proceeding. However, the Utility has chosen only to implement the rates set forth in the PAA Order. The collection of the PAA rates will be held subject to refund should the ultimate increase be less than that in the PAA Order.

The increased rates and charges are effective for service on or after five days from the date of this Notice.

The rates prior to filing and the PAA Order wastewater rates are attached to this customer notice. The Commission also authorized an increase in customer deposits, and service availability charges as set forth on the attached.

This notice was prepared by the Utility and approved by the Commission Staff for distribution by the Utility to its customers.

CUSTOMER DEPOSITS

<u>ESTABLISHMENT OF CREDIT</u> - Before rendering wastewater service, the Company may require an Applicant for service to satisfactorily establish credit, but such establishment of credit shall not relieve the Customer from complying with the Company's rules for prompt payment. Credit will be deemed so established if the Customer complies with the requirements of Rule 25-30.311, Florida Administrative Code

AMOUNT OF DEPOSIT - The amount of initial deposit shall be the following according to meter size:

Residential

General Service

\$156.00

Estimated Charge for service for 2 billing periods

<u>ADDITIONAL DEPOSIT</u> - Under Rule 25-30.311(7), Florida Administrative Code, the Company may require a new deposit, where previously waived or returned, or an additional deposit in order to secure payment of current bills provided.

<u>INTEREST ON DEPOSIT</u> - The Company shall pay interest on Customer deposits pursuant to Rules 25-30.311(4) and (4a). The Company will pay or credit accrued interest to the Customer's once each year.

<u>REFUND OF DEPOSIT</u> - After a residential Customer has established a satisfactory payment record and has had continuous service for a period of 23 months, the Company shall refund the Customer's deposit provided the Customer has met the requirements of Rule 25-30.311(5), Florida Administrative Code. The Company may hold the deposit of a non-residential Customer after a continuous service period of 23 months and shall pay interest on the non-residential Customer's deposit pursuant to Rules 25-30.311(4) and (5), Florida Administrative Code.

Nothing in this rule shall prohibit the Company from refunding a Customer's deposit in less than 23 months.
