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## PROCEEDINGS

**CHAIRMAN BROWN:** On to Item 6, which also has an oral modification.

MS. MATTHEWS: Good morning, Commissioners.

I'm Traci Matthews with staff.

Item 16 is a petition for approval of a new environmental program for cost recovery through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause by Tampa Electric Company. This item addresses TECO's proposed compliance plan designed to implement the EPA's final Coal Combustion Residuals Rule, also known as the CCR Rule.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Traci, can you speak up a little bit?

MS. MATTHEWS: Oh, I'm sorry, which became effective on October 19th, 2015. After staff's recommendation was filed, TECO filed an amended petition to request that the capital cost for these activities be allocated to rate classes on a demand basis rather that on an energy basis as stated in the original petition. The O&M costs are still allocated on an energy basis. Because FPL, DEF, and Gulf all had similar programs with similar allocations, staff did not oppose TECO's request. The change produced a very small increase to the bill impacts for residential

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customers, less than 1 cent.

Commissioners have been provided with three oral modifications to staff's recommendation, and those changes are available in the docket file as part of the case record. Staff recommends that TECO's proposed CCR compliance plan is necessary for compliance with the CCR Rule and that it be approved for cost recovery through the ECRC. Staff notes that the reasonableness and prudence of all expenditures and cost allocation will continue to be subject to the Commission's review in future ECRC proceedings. Late yesterday Sierra Club filed comments in this docket. Staff is available for any questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you so much.

Commissioners, any questions or discussion on this item? I'll entertain a motion.

COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Move staff.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Is there a second?

**COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** Second.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: All those in favor.
