CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 8. Thank you.

MS. OLLILA: Good morning, Commissioners.

Sue Ollila for staff.

Item 8 is a joint petition from Tampa Electric and Mosaic requesting Commission approval of their joint termination of a 2003 settlement agreement. That agreement was actually between Tampa Electric and Cargill. One year after the agreement was reached in 2004, Mosaic was formed by a merger between Cargill's crop nutrition division and IMC Global, a fertilizer company formed in 1909.

Mosaic is a large phosphate mining company that produces energy for its own use and sells excess energy to Tampa Electric. The 2003 agreement provided for certain operational arrangements, excuse me, between Mosaic and Tampa Electric that both parties state they no longer desire. The agreement which ended in 2007 specifies that either party may terminate the agreement with one year's written notice. Neither party requires the one-year notice. The agreement only impacts Tampa Electric and Mosaic and does not affect Tampa Electric's general body of ratepayers. There were no customer contacts, and staff recommends approval of the joint
