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CHAIRMAN BROWN: We're moving through today.

MS. GUFFEY: Item 10 is Peoples Gas System's request to discontinue multiple purchased gas adjustment factors for residential customers and commercial customers. The company's proposal is based on three main factors.

First, under the current methodology to calculate the different PGA factors, the residential class pays a slightly higher PGA factor than the commercial customers.

Second, the commercial customers have the option to purchase gas from a third-party gas marketer and -- which many commercial customers have been purchasing gas for the past few years.

Then thirdly, a single PGA would reduce the administrative burden of calculating and maintaining separate PGA factors. The single PGA factor will be calculated according to the methodology adopted by the Commission in 1991 and used by investor-owned gas utilities to calculate the PGA factor.

Staff did not receive any customer comments on this proposed petition, and staff recommends approval of discontinuing multiple PGA factors.

12	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. So all of the other
13	IOUs use a single factor.
14	MS. GUFFEY: Yes, they do.
15	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. Commissioners,
16	any questions, comments?
