All,

Pursuant to miscellaneous informal requests I have attached some documents. First, the CIAC received in 2015 is:

A/C 271.1000 as of 12/31/2015 \$10,389,043 A/C 271.1000 as of 12/31/2014 \$10,083,008 2015 Additional CIAC \$306,035

As you can see by the attached bids, the plant expansion will cost in excess of \$1million more than was used in the calculations in the Staff Recommendation. KWRU is continuing to try to whittle down the amount and expects to sign a contract on Friday. Based upon this significant increase in cost of the pro forma plant, I think it is premature to require the Utility to cease collecting and to refund service availability charges. I think this should be handled as the Commission handled the WMSI pro form plant expansion, including it in the revenue requirement with a true-up at the end. This was also done for CIAC in the WMSI case. An oral modification could resolve that issue.
