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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 10.
3	Good morning.
4	MS. BUYS: Commissioners, I am Penelope Buys
5	with a Commission staff.
6	Item 10 is Sanlando Utilities Corporation's
7	application to amend its service area in Seminole
8	County.
9	Sanlando plans to extend the service area to
10	include Myrtle Lake Hills subdivision. The
11	residents of the subdivision are experiencing
12	deteriorating water quality from their individual
13	wells. A majority of the residents in the
14	subdivision wish to have their water provided by
15	the Sanlando.
16	Two residents provided written comments to the
17	Commission expressing their approval of the
18	amendment request before the staff recommendation
19	was filed. One of the residents, who also spoke
20	with Commission staff, provided lab results of the
21	water from her well. The lab results indicated the
22	iron exceeded DEP's standards.
23	Since the staff recommendation was filed, six
24	more residents provided written comments expressing
25	their approval of the amendment request.

1	Sanlando is also requesting to collect a main
2	extension charge of \$5,526 per lot from the
3	residents of the subdivision. The residents of the
4	subdivision will be the only customers of Sanlando
5	to pay this charge, and it is to help pay for the
6	infrastructure of the subdivision.
7	Since the residents of the subdivision will be
8	the only customers paying for the main extension
9	charge, Sanlando is also requesting the waiver of
10	the Rule 25-30.565 FAC, application for new for
11	approval of new or revised service availability
12	policy charges.
13	The documents required by this rule will cause
14	a hardship on the utility since the residents of
15	the subdivision will only account for approximately
16	one percent of Sanlando's customer base.
17	Staff is recommending approval of the a
18	amendment, approval of the rule waiver, and
19	approval of the main extension charge.
20	We are available for questions.
21	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.
22	Staff, I have a question about this. What
23	do you know what DEP is doing on about the iron
24	levels in residents' wells who don't choose to
25	become customers of Sanlando?

1	MS. BUYS: I don't think they have
2	jurisdiction over the individual wells. I am not
3	sure, though. Just over the potable water from the
4	private companies.
5	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Are it appears that the
6	maximum contaminant levels are exceeding, at least
7	on some of these that are cited in the staff
8	recommendation.
9	MS. BUYS: Just on that on one result we
10	got, the iron really exceeded DEP standards, but I
11	don't know if DEP can do anything about the
12	individual levels.
13	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. Thank you.
14	Commissioners, any other questions?
15	COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Move staff.
16	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Is there a second?
17	COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Second.
18	CHAIRMAN BROWN: All those in favor, say aye.
