## Dear Commissioners;

I am a long time resident of Indian River Shores, Florida. As residents of Indian River Shores we have had to pay significantly higher rates for electricity that is supplied by the City of Vero Beach. The higher rates have been used to fund the general fund of Vero Beach which have nothing to do with the city's utility operation. This excess money coming into the Vero Beach general fund has encouraged the city council to make poor decisions over the years and to enter into ridiculous and expensive contacts.
