The current arrangement which causes the city of Vero Beach("City") to provide our electric service is unfair in that the City prices the electricity to make a profit to subsidize the revenues of the city at my expense. I am not a resident of the City so I can not vote my displeasure so have no voice in the operation or pricing of the utility. In addition to the profit charged by the City, their costs are excessive due to the poor management of the Florida Municipal Power League of which it is a part..
