By Order No. PSC-16-0123-PAA-SU, in Docket No. 150071-SU, issued March 23, 2016, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved an increase in wastewater rates for KW Resort Utilities Corp. (Utility). A schedule of Commission approved rates are set forth below. The Phase II Rates will be effective upon completion of the expansion of the wastewater treatment plant. The Office of Public Counsel and Monroe County have protested the PAA Order, and pursuant to law the Utility may implement its requested rate increase during the pendency of the protest proceeding. However, the Utility has chosen only to implement the rates set forth in the PAA Order. The collection of the PAA rates will be held subject to refund should the ultimate increase be less than that in the PAA Order.

The Commission has also authorized the Utility to collect miscellaneous service charges as initial connection, normal reconnection, violation reconnection, and premises visit charges, as follows:

Charge	Current	Commission Approved

The Commission also authorized the Utility to collect NSF charges consistent with Section 68.065, F.S., which allows for the assessment of charges for the collection of worthless checks, drafts, or orders of payment. As currently set forth in Section 68.065(2), F.S., the following NSF charges may be assessed:

- (1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50,
- (2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300,
- (3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- (4) Or five percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.

The Commission also approved the Utility to charge a \$6.50 late payment charge.

The rates shall be effective for service rendered as of the Commission's stamped approval date on the tariff sheets provided the customers have received notice. If the effective date of the new rates falls within a regular billing cycle, the initial bills at the new rate may be prorated. The old charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle before the effective date of the new rates. The new charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle on or after the effective date of the new rates.
