Dear Commissioner Brown:

As you know, the Town of Indian River Shores has a petition before the PSC to re-draw service boundaries to allow the Town to select its own provider.

As a resident of Indian River Shores I would like to add my voice to the others you have heard asking you and the rest of the Commission to approve this petition. Our residents would be able to secure electricity rates substantially lower than the outrageous rates we pay to the City of Vero Beach...rates which allow the City to artificially reduce overall tax rates to City residents by using the annual \$4 million +/- electrical utility surplus to help fund the general budget.

We, Indian River Shores residents, have no say in the rate structure...in fact, we cannot even vote for the Vero Beach Commissioners who manage the City, and, ultimately, the electric utility.

In making your decision I would ask you to mentally briefly put yourself in our shoes...would you be willing to accept this kind of forced subsidy to a municipal government you had absolutely no say in electing or controlling?
