PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF CODE DENIAL

Windstream Florida, LLC ("Windstream") petitions the Public Service Commission of Florida ("Commission") pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(4), the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC's") *Numbering Optimization First Report & Order*, ¹ and Commission Order No. PSC-01-1873-PCO-TL, to review and overturn a recent decision by the Pooling Administrator ("PA") to withhold certain numbering resources from Windstream needed by the company to continue to provide reliable and adequate service to customers. In support of its Petition Windstream states:

PARTIES

- 1. Windstream is an incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") authorized to provide telecommunications services in designated service territories in the State of Florida.
- 2. Neustar is the corporation authorized by the FCC to perform the functions of the national PA.

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(4) and Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).

This provision provides that a carrier may challenge Neustar's decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 4. On April 16, 2015, Windstream filed a request with the PA for a single "thousands" block of numbers for a Local Routing Number ("LRN") to serve customers in Windstream's Hastings rate center. A copy of the Application is attached as **EXHIBIT 1**.
- 5. The additional numbering resources are required to permit Windstream to provide service via a new packet switch that is being deployed to complete a project supported by the FCC's Connect America Fund Phase II ("CAF2") in the Hastings, Florida rate center. Pursuant to the applicable industry *Location Routing Number (LRN) Assignment Practices document (ATIS-0300065)*, Windstream must establish a unique LRN to identify the recipient switch or POI and must establish one LRN per LATA per switch from an assigned NXX for the recipient switch in the number portability capable network. Thus, Windstream must obtain an LRN for this new packet switch. Also pursuant to industry guidelines, only an NXX code holder can obtain an LRN, thus necessitating Windstream's request for an NXX code, for the Hastings rate center. (It should be noted, however, that Windstream would retain only a single thousand-number-block from the new NXX code.)
- 6. On May 11, 2016, the PA denied Windstream's request on the grounds that Windstream had not satisfied the months-to-exhaust ("MTE") criteria established in the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines. A copy of the PA's denial is attached as **EXHIBIT 2**.
- 7. Windstream has demonstrated a verifiable need due to its needs in connection with a CAF2 project upgrade to this rural exchange.

- 8. Windstream cannot satisfy the need for numbering resources from its current inventory or in any other manner and has exhausted all other available remedies.
- 9. FCC rules make it clear that a carrier may challenge a numbering resource denial by the PA before the appropriate state regulatory commission and that the state commission has jurisdiction to affirm or overturn the PA's decision to withhold numbering resources.² The FCC specifically grants state commissions "flexibility to direct the NANPA or Pooling Administrator to assign additional numbering resources to carriers that have demonstrated a verifiable need for additional numbering resources outside of these specifically enumerated instances."³ In particular, in establishing the safety valve, the FCC recognized that conditions that could give rise to a need for additional numbering resources "might include situations where a carrier has multiple switches within a rate center but it is unable to readily share numbering resources among those switches."⁴
- 10. As set forth above, Windstream has demonstrated a verifiable need due to a deployment of a new switch and corresponding new service in connection with a CAF2 project upgrade to this rural exchange. The Commission has previously received similar requests from carriers, both ILECs and CLECs in which the carriers have asked the Commission to overrule a decision of the PA. The Commission has granted these requests.⁵

- 11. Granting Windstream's Petition will not adversely affect the numbering resources available for use by carriers throughout the state in providing telecommunications services to their customers. Granting Windstream's request is in the public interest and consistent with the FCC's rules and decisions.
- 12. Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission act upon this Petition within ten business days. Expedited treatment is required to meet the needs of the persons to be served through the switch and Windstream's internal business plans and schedule.
 - 13. The FCC also has recognized the importance of timely action:

[W]e recognize that in many instances, the failure to address a request for additional numbering resources can impair a carrier's ability to stay in or expand business. We therefore direct states to act on carrier requests for a safety valve as expeditiously as possible. Although we do not establish a specific time limit for states to act on these requests, we believe that, in most instances, 10 business days from receipt of a request that the state determines to be sufficiently detailed and complete will be sufficient time to review and act upon safety valve requests.⁶

WHEREFORE, Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission:

- 1. Overturn the PA's decision;
- 2. Direct the PA to grant Windstream's requests for numbering resources; and
- 3. Enter an Order doing so within ten business days, or as soon thereafter as is possible; and
- 4. Grant Windstream such further relief as may be appropriate.




