#### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PARKLAND, FLORIDA OPPOSING FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S PETITION FOR A BASE RATE **INCREASE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2016, Florida Power & Light ("FPL") filed a petition with the Florida Public Service Commission ("PSC") requesting an increase in the four-year base rate for 2017-2020; and

WHEREAS, approval of this petition, identified as PSC Docket No. 160021, would increase typical residential customer rates by \$13.28 per month; and

14 WHEREAS, approval of this rate increase would increase typical business electrical costs 15 by 2-6% per year; and

17 WHEREAS, approval of this rate increase petition would increase electric costs to the City 18 of Parkland ("City") by ten (10) percent in 2017, three (3) percent in 2018 and an addition two (2) percent in 2019. 20
