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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Item 10, which has an oral modification, I believe, that has been distributed.

MR. HIGGINS: Good morning, Commissioners.

Devlin Higgins with Commission staff.

The oral modification is on the middle of page 1. It just should have been noted that this is a proposed agency action item.

Item 10 addresses Florida Power & Light's petition for approval of its 2015 decommissioning study, which was filed in accordance with Commission rule.

After reviewing the company's current decommissioning cost study and discovery responses on this matter, staff recommends the Commission find that the appropriate base rate annual accrual to recover the future costs of decommissioning both at the Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Station and the St. Lucie Nuclear Power Plant be set at zero dollars per year.

Additionally, staff recommends the Commission approve updated end of life nuclear materials and supplies and last core of nuclear fuel amortization expenses, which are the subjects of Issues 3 and 4. This would result in a cumulative annual revenue requirement reduction of approximately \$116,000 per year. Staff is not aware of any specific issues or
