CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 11.

MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Commissioners. Sevini Guffey with the Commission staff.

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Item 11 is Gulf Power Company's petition to extend its experimental business incentive riders until December 31st, 2017. The riders were introduced during Gulf's 2013 rate case as a pilot program for a period of three years beginning January 1st, 2014, until December 31st, 2016. The riders, which require a five-year service contract, provides reduced base rates for new businesses that meet certain criteria such as qualifying electric load, job creation, and verifying that the availability of the riders were a significant factor in moving or locating to the service area of the company.

The intention of the riders is to promote economic growth. The company currently has two customers on the riders and has received commitments from two new customers. And the two new customers have started initial construction work, but will not be able to take service before the rider expires on December 31st of this year. Additionally, Gulf is also negotiating with -- for potential customers; therefore, the company is requesting an additional year, an

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extension of an additional year.

Staff is not of aware of any customer complaints or correspondence regarding this docket. And staff recommends approval of this petition and is available to answer questions and -- any questions, and the company's representatives are also here to answer questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you so much.

I think this is a great program. We just approved a similar program in the -- in TECO -- for TECO last month, and that was on a permanent basis. I'm curious, this one seems even more promising and has achieved more tangible customers and commitments. Do you know why they opted to make it a pilot, continue the pilot?

MS. GUFFEY: So it will give additional time for the current customers who are under construction currently, and then also they want to get additional data to see if the program is successful and whether they will continue as is or continue with revisions or amendments later on or discontinue after December 31st of next year.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Great. Looking forward to seeing it become permanent. Thank you.

MS. GUFFEY: Thank you. Yes.

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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Commissioners, any other questions? COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Move staff. COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Second.
