In regards to the FPL rate increase final hearing, docket number 160021-E1, I respectfully submit the following:

As an FPL customer, I am opposed to the rate increase on the grounds that the total compensation paid to Nextera executives is excessive, especially for a public utility. I believe that Nextera's financial strategy benefits executives and stockholders preferentially over ratepayers. I believe in <u>reasonable</u> executive compensation and <u>reasonable</u> returns on equity for investors. I also believe that the total compensation of the top 5 NEE executives, which DOUBLED from roughly \$16 million in 2011, to \$32 million in 2015 (based on data found in NEE proxy reports and annual statements), is UNREASONABLY HIGH. The ongoing cost-cutting efforts of FPL should result in significant savings to ratepayers, but these savings will not be realized due to the rate increase which will essentially provide a higher payout to investors and further increases in NEE executive compensation. I would summarize my opinion of this requested rate hike as PURE GREED and therefore recommend that it be rejected.
