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2 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Moving on to Item 11.

3 Good morning, Ms. Guffey and Ms. Leathers.

4 **MS. GUFFEY:** Good morning, Madam Chairman and
5 Commissioners.

6 Item 11 is a petition filed by Duke Energy
7 Florida requesting three tariff modifications. The first
8 request is to modify Duke's premier power service tariff
9 to allow interruptible and curtailable service customers
10 to participate in the premier power service tariff. This
11 tariff is available to commercial customers who require
12 onsite generators for backup electric power supply.

13 The second modifications are minor
14 modifications to the local government underground tariff
15 which was approved by the Commission in 2002. Duke's
16 third request is to seek approval of a new local
17 government contract -- local government underground cost
18 recovery contract form. Although the currently approved
19 underground tariff refers to a cost recovery form, the
20 company does not have an approved standard contract form.
21 This form tracks the requirements of the underground
22 tariff and establishes the specific terms and conditions
23 for underground cost recovery.

24 Staff has reviewed Duke's proposed petition and
25 tariff modifications and their responses to staff's data

1 requests and believes the proposed modifications are
2 reasonable.

3 Staff is not aware of any customer complaints
4 or correspondence regarding this docket and recommends
5 approval of this petition. Staff is available to answer
6 questions. And Duke representatives are also here to
7 answer questions the Commission may have.

8 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Thank you for the very
9 detailed intro.

10 **MS. GUFFEY:** Thank you.

11 **CHAIRMAN BROWN:** Commissioners, any questions
