CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 11.

Good morning, Ms. Guffey and Ms. Leathers.

MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Madam Chairman and Commissioners.

Item 11 is a petition filed by Duke Energy Florida requesting three tariff modifications. The first request is to modify Duke's premier power service tariff to allow interruptible and curtailable service customers to participate in the premier power service tariff. This tariff is available to commercial customers who require onsite generators for backup electric power supply.

The second modifications are minor modifications to the local government underground tariff which was approved by the Commission in 2002. Duke's third request is to seek approval of a new local government contract -- local government underground cost recovery contract form. Although the currently approved underground tariff refers to a cost recovery form, the company does not have an approved standard contract form. This form tracks the requirements of the underground tariff and establishes the specific terms and conditions for underground cost recovery.

Staff has reviewed Duke's proposed petition and tariff modifications and their responses to staff's data
