FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF AMENDED LATE FILED EXHIBIT 4 TO DEPOSITION OF ROBERT BARRETT

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4 to the deposition of Robert E. Barrett ("Barrett Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. The deposition of Robert E. Barrett took place on August 3, 2016. At that time, Mr. Barrett was asked to provide certain information as late filed deposition exhibits. His late filed deposition exhibits 4 and 6 contained confidential information. Accordingly, on August 11, 2016, FPL filed a Request for Confidential Classification of those two exhibits. Thereafter, the Office of Public Counsel requested that Mr. Barrett provide an amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4. The information contained in Barrett Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4 is confidential. 2. The following exhibits are included herewith and made a part of this request:

a. Exhibit A consists of a copy of Barrett Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4.

b. Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Barrett Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4 on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment is redacted.

c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the file provided in Exhibit A. Exhibit C also references the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and identifies the declarant who supports of the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D contains the declaration of Robert E. Barrett in support of this Request.

3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determined that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As described more fully in the declaration included as Exhibit D, Barrett Amended Late Filed Deposition Exhibit 4 relates to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat.

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5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information remains proprietary and confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for at least an additional eighteen (18) month period and should be returned to FPL as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and declarations included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
