Enclosed is Permit Number CS41-0026257-024-DWC/CM to construct a domestic wastewater collection/transmission system, issued pursuant to 403.087(1), Florida Statutes.

The Department's proposed agency action shall become final unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, within fourteen days of receipt of notice. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received by the Clerk) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Under Rule 62-110.106(4), Florida Administrative Code, a person may request an extension of the time for filing a petition for an administrative hearing. The request must be filed (received by the Clerk) in the Office of General Counsel before the end of the time period for filing a petition for an administrative hearing.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the persons listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), Florida Statutes, must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. Section 120.60(3), Florida Statutes, however, also allows that any person who has asked the Department in writing for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication.

The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition or request for extension of time within fourteen days

of receipt of notice shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, Florida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information, as indicated in Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code:

- (a) The name and address of each agency affected, each agency's file or identification number, if known, and the county in which the project is located;
- (b) The name, address, any e-mail address, any facsimile number, and telephone number of the petitioner, if the petitioner is not represented by an attorney or a qualified representative; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any; which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the determination;
- (c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the Department's decision;
- (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's proposed action;
- (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's proposed action, including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the Department to take with respect to the Department's proposed action.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation under Section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available for this proceeding.

This permit action is final on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a petition (or request for extension of time) is filed in accordance with the above. Upon the timely filing of a petition (or request for an extension of time), this permit will not be effective until further order of the Department.

Any party to the permit has the right to seek judicial review of the permit action under Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a notice of appeal under Rules 9.110 and 9.190, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date when this permit action is filed with the Clerk of the Department.

Upon completion of construction of the collection/transmission system project, and before placing the facilities into operation for any purpose other than testing for leaks or testing equipment operation, the permittee shall submit to the Department's Southwest District Office Form 62-604.300(8)(b), Request for Approval to Place a Domestic Wastewater Collection/Transmission System into Operation. - 3. The new or modified collection/transmission facilities shall not be placed into service until the Department clears the project for use. [62-604.700(3)]
- 4. Permit revisions shall only be made in accordance with Rule 62-4.050(4)(s), F.A.C. Request for revisions shall be made to the Department in writing and shall include the appropriate fee. Revisions not covered under Rule 62-4.050(4)(s), F.A.C., shall require a new permit. [62-604.600(8)]

For unauthorized spills of wastewater in excess of 1000 gallons per incident, or where information indicates that public health or the environment may be endangered, oral reports shall be provided to the STATE WATCH OFFICE TOLL FREE NUMBER, (800) 320-0519, as soon as practical, but no later than 24 hours from the time the permittee or other designee becomes aware of the circumstances. Unauthorized releases or spills less than 1000 gallons per incident are to be reported orally to the Department's Southwest District Office within 24 hours from the time the permittee, or other designee becomes aware of the circumstances. - 6. This permit is for CONSTRUCTION ONLY of the collection/transmission system project. This permit does not authorize the connection of this collection/transmission system project to the designated wastewater treatment plant. The Department has received your Request for Approval to Place a Domestic Wastewater Collection/Transmission System into Operation [FDEP Form 62-604.300(8)(b)] and supporting documents for the above-referenced project. This project was approved for construction under the permit application number described above, issued on April 17, 2015. The engineer of record certified that a portion of the collection/transmission system has been completed without substantial deviations.

The submitted documents indicate compliance with the clearance procedures identified in Rule 62-604.700, Florida Administrative Code (FAC). Therefore, the Department is issuing this letter of release to place the portion of the above-referenced domestic wastewater collection/transmission system into service. Pursuant to 62-604.700, FAC portions of this project that have not been cleared for service may not be placed into operation for any purpose other than testing for leaks or equipment operation.

You must comply with any changes in applicable laws and regulations that affect operating procedures and/or quality standards, and be aware of and operate under the general conditions included in your permit. I will be ordering a title search for Lot 53, Signal Cove Unit Four, to determine what easements are on the property. I will also contact a surveyor to survey Lot 53, Signal Cove Unit Four, to locate where the utilities are situated.

Question 6: In response to staff's first data request, Item 6, the utility provided billing detail related to contractual services – legal expense. The responses included 9.1 hours, or \$3,165, for work related to the four-year rate reduction. Please explain why it was necessary for an attorney to perform this work.

Response: These are costs incurred by the utility in attempting to implement the rate reduction required by statute, rule and commission order. It is reasonable for the utility to have incurred these costs. In this case the utility's attorney was first contacted by the commission staff attorney concerning this required rate reduction. The company attorney then reviewed the applicable orders, statute, rules and tariffs. Then the attorney discussed the issues involved with the utility management, and sought the advice of PSC technical & legal Staff concerning interpretation of the commission's order, the statute, and applicable rule. Thereafter the utility's attorney assisted the company in the proper calculation of reduced rates and development of appropriate notices and tariffs and coordination with the FPSC staff to accomplish the required reduction and refunds. These are therefore appropriate costs for recovery and it was necessary and prudent for an attorney to be involved in the process.

Question 7: In response to staffs first data request, Item 7, one of the expenses was related to an audit of the entire Ni Florida wastewater collection system totaling \$17,851.12. Please explain how often the utility performs this type of audit, when the last audit took place, and how the utility uses the results. As part of your response, please provide a copy of the audit findings.

Response: This audit of the entire Ni Florida wastewater collection system was done to for the first time to identify customers in the service area that were on the system, those homes in the service area that were not on the system, and to note whether or not the customer has an Elder Valve installed. It is Ni Florida's plan to do this type of audit every three years. A copy of the customer audit findings would be voluminous. The report from the audit of the Hudson collection system is available for review by the Staff of the FPSC at the Utility Group of Florida, LLC office in Port Richey, Florida.

Question 8: Please explain why wastewater contractual services — other expense has increased substantially since the utility's last rate case. Include in your response whether the utility anticipates a reduction in any portion of this expense going forward as a result of the completion of the pro forma projects being considered in this rate case.

Response: In order to maintain this old wastewater collection system, it is necessary to spend enough money on maintenance to attempt to reduce I&I and eliminate or reduce chlorides and sanitary sewer overflows. Ni Florida is committed to spend whatever level on maintenance to accomplish this. Some years will have higher spending on contract maintenance and some years will have less spending on contract maintenance. Some of the maintenance spending is mandatory and cannot be delayed from one year to the next. For the two pro forma projects, Tower Drive and Rhodes Road, the maintenance for whose would be expected to be minimal in the first few years. The utility believes that the costs incurred in this account during the test year are reasonable and represent an appropriate average of the costs that the utility will incur in the future in properly maintaining the system.

Florida Public Service Commission Staff's Second Data Reguest

Question 9: Please explain why miscellaneous expenses for water and wastewater have increased by over 88 percent and 75 percent, respectively, since the utility's last rate case.

Response: Miscellaneous Expenses have increased since the last Ni Florida, LLC rate case. However, Ni Florida believes it would be better to compare the "as filed" amounts from the current rate case with the "as filed" amounts from the last rate case. This comparison would result in an increase of 31% for Tamiami water and an increase of 21% for Hudson wastewater over the 3-year period. While these percentage increases are more than Ni Florida would have hoped for, it remains much more reasonable than the 88% increase for Tamiami water and the 75% for Hudson wastewater, as stated in the question. In the last rate case, the FPSC allowed 62% of the Tamiami water Miscellaneous Expenses requested (as filed vs ordered) and 68% of the Hudson wastewater Miscellaneous Expenses requested (as filed vs ordered). The attachment details these calculated percentages. Ni Florida feels certain that the percentage increases of "as ordered" Miscellaneous Expenses for both water and wastewater when compared to the "as ordered" Miscellaneous Expenses from the last rate case will be more reasonable than the 88% and 75% noted in the question.

ACTUAL BILLINGS

The utility expended approximately \$74,000 in preparation and filing of the rate proceeding in Docket 150170-WS which was ultimately withdrawn. While the great majority of the costs related to this proceeding are not relevant to the current rate case proceeding, most of the costs related to legal services incurred during the three months prior rate case filing are directly related to the information necessary in order to file the current rate proceeding in Docket 160030-WS. The costs for drafting of pleadings, organization of tariffs and exhibits which were the focus of the three legal bills just prior to the filing were substantially similar to those filed in the instant rate proceeding. As such, the utility believes that a significant portion of the rate case expenses incurred for legal services in those three months directly benefit the current rate proceeding. In an attempt to estimate conservatively, the utility has allocated 50% of the cost of those services as costs related to the current rate proceeding. Those costs have been included in the current estimate of total rate case expense attached. The bills from that period of time are attached.
