FPL is already earning more than 9 percent returns in a business that is protected from competition by state law. Now they want returns of up to 12.5 percent.

Meanwhile, many Florida residential rate-payers struggle to earn 2 percent on their savings and investments. For consumers, the proposed rate increase means an annual increase of \$160 a year within four years. FPL is also trying to increase the fixed part of your utility bill, a fee that you must pay before you even turn on the lights.
