MR. ELLIS: My apologies. Good morning,

Commissioners. Philip Ellis with Commission staff.

Item 9 is Duke Energy Florida's petition for approval of the third stipulation to amend the revised and restated stipulation and settlement agreement, or RRSSA. The stipulation has been signed by the parties to the original RRSSA, including Duke, Office of Public Counsel, Florida Industrial Power Users Group, PCS Phosphate, and the Florida Retail Federation. It addresses the remaining portion of the CR3 regulatory asset, the dry cask storage facility.

The rest of the CR3 regulatory asset has been addressed in two prior amendments to the RRSSA and has been securitized. The third amendment shifts recovery for the dry cask storage facility from a base rate adder adjusted every four years to the capacity cost recovery clause with an annual review. In addition, any DOE awards for spent fuel will be credited to the capacity clause. Staff recommends approval of the third amendment to the RRSSA. No customer comments have been filed, and staff is available for any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Ellis.

Commissioners, any questions?

I have a couple of questions for staff. And I

understand the reasoning for shifting recovery from the base rates to the clauses and that it was also contemplated by the settlement agreement as well.

Do we have an estimated impact that this will have on the rates, though, for 2016?

MR. ELLIS: I do not have that with me at the moment, but I do know it is included in their 2013 projection filing that will be addressed in the 01 clause, so.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. And with regard to the DOE, and we had discussions previously in my briefings on DOE awards to Duke, how much has been awarded from DOE for the DS -- pardon me -- dry cask storage costs so far?

MR. ELLIS: Currently Duke has received an award of 17.7 million associated with costs from the 2006 to 2010 period. It is my understanding there's currently litigation going on for costs from -- between 2010 and 2013. They're anticipating, based on their response to staff's data request, approximately 21 million in 2018. There will also be a future filing for other costs, from my understanding, past the 2013
