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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 11.

MS. OLLILA: Good morning, Commissioners. Sue Ollila for staff.

Item 11 is Florida Power & Light's petition for approval of revisions to its residential and commercial underground differential tariffs. The residential differential tariffs are filed pursuant to Rule 25-6.078, Florida Administrative Code. They apply to new developments and represent the additional costs FPL incurs to provide underground distribution service in place of overhead service.

Rule 25-6.078 requires current labor and material costs be used and that the company file supporting data and analyses, which FPL has done. The residential differentials have either decreased or remained at zero dollars under the proposed rates. The primary reason for the decrease are larger increases in overhead labor and material costs than in underground labor and material costs. There have been no customer contacts, and staff recommends approval of the residential and commercial distribution tariffs.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. And this looks like a very exciting endeavor. It actually shows that underground -- undergrounding is more cost-effective.
