ISSUE 4: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

DEF: The new factors should be effective beginning with the first billing cycle for January 2017, and thereafter through the last billing cycle for December 2017. The first billing cycle may start before January 2017, and the last billing cycle may end after December 31, 2017, so long as each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the factors became effective. (Cross)
