MS. TAN: Good morning, Commissioners. Lee Eng Tan on behalf of Commission staff. Item 2 is a joint motion by Duke, FPL, Gulf, TECO, FPUC for a waiver of Rule 25-17.015(1)(b), Florida Administrative Code, in the Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Clause docket, Docket No. 160002 .

Rule 25-17.015(1)(b) requires that the electric utilities make actual and estimated filings based upon eight months of actual data and four months of projected data. Duke, FPL, Gulf, TECO, and FPUC have asked that the rule be waived and request a file based upon six months of actual data and six months of estimated data. The companies are all available for questions, and staff is also available for questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Ms. Tan. Why a two-year waiver? Based on the facts, it seems that it should only apply to this year.

MS. TAN: Staff is planning on taking a rule change, and we're looking to do that within the next -in the near future.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: What would the rule change? What's the proposed rule change?

MS. TAN: We are looking to change the time 1 2 frame of -- from being in the rule to -- into another 3 format, perhaps into the Order Establishing Procedure, but that is to be determined. 4 5 CHAIRMAN BROWN: When can we expect to see 6 something? MS. TAN: In the near future. 7 CHAIRMAN BROWN: That's spoken like a lawyer. 8 9 (Laughter.) 10 MS. TAN: We are looking to take it within the 11 next year.
