Dear Ms. Stauffer:

Enclosed for filing on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company (“FPL”) is a correction to Thirty-Second Revised Tariff Sheet No. 8.542 for Rate Schedule CST-3 (the “CST-3 Tariff Sheet”), which was included as page 76 of 107 in Exhibit B to the Stipulation and Settlement that was approved by the Commission on November 29, 2016 to resolve all issues in the above and consolidated dockets.

FPL has recently determined that the CST-3 Tariff Sheet included in Exhibit B reflects incorrect (slightly high) non-fuel energy charges for the on- and off-peak periods. Specifically, the non-fuel energy charges should be 1.217 cents per kWh (on-peak) and 1.016 cents per kWh (off-peak), rather than 1.227 cents per kWh (on-peak) and 1.019 cents per kWh (off-peak) as reflected on the CST-3 Tariff Sheet that was included in Exhibit B. The enclosed CST-3 Tariff Sheet corrects those non-fuel energy charges, and FPL asks that the Commission substitute it into the set of tariff sheets that are approved pursuant to the November 29, 2016 decision.
