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CHAIRMAN BROWN: We are moving on to Item 3.

MS. HARPER: I'm back.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: You're back. You haven't

MS. HARPER: Item 3 has to do with some water and wastewater rules, Commissioners. During the 2016 legislative session, the Florida Legislature modified two subsections of the water statutes pertaining to staff assistance in rate case and also recovery of pass-through adjustments. To implement the new laws, staff's recommended rule amendments will update and streamline the Commission rules consistent with this new law, and staff is available for any questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.

Staff, in your recommendation on page 4, it talks about possible options that staff is working on reviewing for improving public access to information that will address the concern that Office of Public Counsel has raised outside of the rulemaking process. Can you elaborate a little bit more?

MS. HARPER: Yes. Public Counsel raised the issue of being notified when a pass-through had been approved. Currently the process, because it's administrative and very quick and sometimes, you know, a

45-day process, the process did not allow for that.

However, we received the comments and we are going to work with them, and I believe have already started providing them with a notification once a pass-through has been approved. So, therefore, they will be able to address any customer comments or questions they may get from customers now that they have this notice.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: So you're going -- staff is going to prepare -- send Public Counsel a notice when Commissioners receive it as well.

MS. HARPER: After the Commissioners receive
it --

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay.

MS. HARPER: -- they will -- I believe they will be forwarded an email that will give them the same type of notification that the Commissioners receive, and that'll be the process for now. Eventually this will be an online system. But since we're not there yet, this will hopefully address their concerns in the interim.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. Appreciate that.

Commissioners, any other questions or comments on this proposed rule, which is really just implementing some of the changes that were made during the past session? Can I get a motion?
