MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Madam Chair and Commissioners. Sevini Guffey with the Commission staff.

Item 11 is Florida Public Utilities Company, Fort Meade, and Chesapeake's petition seeking approval of the 2017 Gas Reliability and Infrastructure Programs, or the GRIP programs, cost recovery factors associated with replacing iron and bare steel mains and services.

In 2015 when the Commission approved FPUC's and Chesapeake's currently effective charges, the Commission also approved Fort Meade's new GRIP program to replace 250 steel services. Fort Meade customers will see the GRIP surcharge for the first time in January 2017 bills, and the utility will notify its customers in the 2016, December 2016 bills of the new surcharges.

There's been no customer comments, and staff recommends approval of the 2017 GRIP surcharges. Staff and company representatives are available to answer questions that you may have.
