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## PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. We are reconvening, and we are on Item 12, which is a panel comprised of myself, Commissioner Edgar, and Commissioner Patronis.

Staff, can you do an overview, please?

MS. GALLOWAY: Yes, Commissioner. Item 12 is staff's recommendation detailing the true-up analysis for Water Management Services, Inc.

Water Management Services, Inc., or WMSI, is a water-only utility located in Franklin County and serves approximately 1,895 water customers. In 2011, WMSI applied for an increase in water rates. Their request included a pro forma plant project which consisted of several items. A final order approving these items was issued by the Commission in 2013.

In 2014, after unforeseen delays in securing financing for the project, the utility filed a motion for extension of time to complete the financing and construction requirements of its pro forma plant project. The Commission granted WMSI's motion for extension of time. In addition to granting the motion for extension of time, the Commission ordered the utility to provide support documentation for its proforma plant project once the project was completed and

within 60 days of the issuance of a letter of clearance from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

The DEP letter of clearance was issued on March 31st, 2016. The utility subsequently submitted a copy of the clearance letter from DEP and provided the required support documentation, which allowed staff to perform a true-up of all prudently incurred investments and associated costs.

Staff has reviewed the documentation and has verified that the project has been completed. The true-up analysis compares the pro forma plant project costs that were approved by the Commission in 2013 with the actual cost of the projects that were submitted by the utility.

Based on the true-up analysis, there is a slight increase of 0.29 percent to the approved revenue requirement. And because the increase is so low, staff is recommending no change in rates. Staff is also recommending that the escrow balance be released to the utility pursuant to the final order and that the docket be closed.

Commissioners, initially the utility planned to address the Commission; however, this morning we learned that they are here only to answer any questions that you may have. OPC is also available and staff is

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available.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Ms. Galloway.

And, Mr. Brown, it's been a couple of years.

MS. BROWNLESS: How are you?

CHAIRMAN BROWN: How are you doing?

MR. BROWN: Long time no see.
