Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests continued confidential classification of portions of Exhibit SDS-1 (Confidential Document 01215-15), which was attached to the prefiled testimony of FPL witness Steven D. Scroggs. FPL was granted confidential treatment by Order No. PSC-15-0251-CFO-EI, issued June 24, 2015. The period of confidential treatment granted by the Order will soon expire. FPL asserts that the information subject to the Order warrants continued treatment as proprietary and confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.

Staff has reviewed FPL's confidentiality request and believes the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for continued confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 01215-15 be approved.
