1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN BROWN: All right. We're moving to
3	Item 1.
4	Staff.
5	MR. MOURING: All right. Good morning,
6	Commissioners. I would like to take an opportunity
7	to introduce Daniel Smith. Mr. Smith is a new
8	analyst in the AFD surveillance section. And he'll
9	be introducing Item No. 1 this morning. And this
10	will be his debut appearance at agenda.
11	CHAIRMAN BROWN: You know what that means,
12	Mr. Smith.
13	(Laughter.)
14	MR. SMITH: Good morning, Madam Chair.
15	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Good morning.
16	MR. SMITH: Good morning, Commissioners.
17	Item 1 is staff's recommendation on
18	Crestridge's request for approval on Phase 2 rates
19	related to completed pro forma items.
20	On December 30th, 2015, the Commission
21	approved Phase 1 rates for Crestridge and also
22	approved Phase 2 rates, pending staff's
23	verification that all pro forma items have been
24	completed and the utility had submitted all
25	documentation.

1	In October of 2015, Crestridge excuse me
2	October 2016, Crestridge submitted an application
3	for limited proceeding in regards to additional
4	capital items at the Crestridge location.
5	Due to Crestridge completing the approved
6	Phase 2 pro forma items budget, and in order to
7	reduce the rate-case expense and regulatory lag,
8	staff and utility agreed to subsume the items
9	listed under the limited proceeding into the open
10	Phase 2 SARC, and Crestridge subsequently withdrew
11	their request for the limited proceeding.
12	Crestridge has submitted documentation of
13	completion of the Phase 2 improvements and is now
14	seeking approval to recover rates for the pro forma
15	items as well as the additional capital
16	improvements that were subsumed into Phase 2 of the
17	staff-assisted rate case.
18	There are no intervenors in this docket and no
19	customers have contacted the Commission regarding
20	this matter.
21	Mr. Smallridge from the utility is available
22	to address any Commission concerns. And staff is
23	prepared to answer any questions.
24	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Smith.
25	Commissioner Patronis has a question for you.

1	COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Thank you, Madam
2	Chairman.
3	Thank you for that introduction. Based on
4	your your job description I've got
5	surveillance-camera issues, problems at my home.
6	Can I make arrangements after work for you to come
7	by and look at them?
8	MR. SMITH: I'm sorry, Commissioner. I am not
9	the man for that job. I I apologize.
10	COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Okay. Well, I I
11	misunderstood. Sorry.
12	(Laughter.)
13	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Commissioner
14	Patronis.
15	Mr. Smith, I do have a question on this one.
16	And this the next two are owned by the same
17	utility owner. And the next case does seem a
18	little bit more cleaner and clearer-cut because
19	the increase because basically the increase is
20	lower than what the PSC approved during the
21	original proceeding. This one is actually an
22	increase over what was originally approved.
23	I just want to make sure that our legal folks
24	are comfortable with the noticing. I understand
25	the reasons why you rolled in the limited

1	proceeding into this. I just want to be
2	comfort you all to be comfortable and make us
3	comfortable that there are no noticing or due-
4	process issues.
5	MS. CORBARI: Thank you, Chairman.
6	Legal staff is is comfortable with the way
7	this docket is being presented. This is the reason
8	we are bringing it back to the Commission for
9	approval is the change in the increase.
10	The utility will have to notice its customers
11	of the Phase 2 increase. And there is this is a
12	proposed Agency action. So, there is a protest
13	period, if there's any concerns. And the utility
14	would have to have noticed a limited proceeding as
15	well.
16	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Did they notice the limited
17	proceeding?
18	MS. CORBARI: No. He withdrew it prior to,
19	but he will notice the increase with prior to
20	the rates going into effect
21	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay.
22	MS. CORBARI: if approved.
23	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. And I notice
24	Public Counsel isn't here at the Bench expressing
25	any concerns against it.
