2 CHAIRMAN BROWN: All right. Moving on to  
3 Item 3, which is a transfer application.

4 MR. GRAVES: Good morning, Commissioners.

5 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Morning.

6 MR. GRAVES: Item 3 will be presented by Emily  
7 Knoblauch. She is a Florida State graduate. She's  
8 been here about eight months, now. She's done a  
9 lot of great work. And this is her first time at a  
10 Commission conference.

11 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Great. Thank you.

12 Emily, welcome. You weren't at my briefing.  
13 So, it's nice to see you here --

14 MS. KNOBLAUCH: Good morning.

15 CHAIRMAN BROWN: -- today. Welcome.

16 MS. KNOBLAUCH: Thank you.

17 Item 3 is staff's recommendation on the  
18 application for transfer of Certificate No. 450-W  
19 from Pine Harbor Water Utilities, LLC, to Pine  
20 Harbor Waterworks, Inc., in Lake County.

21 The utility is currently providing water  
22 service to approximately 64 customers. And the  
23 current rates and charges for utility service were  
24 approved by the Commission in 2010.

25 No protests have been made in opposition of

1 the transfer and no customer comments have been  
2 filed in the docket.

3 Staff recommends the Commission should grant  
4 the transfer. And staff is available to answer any  
5 questions at this time.

6 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.

7 Can you tell me how to pronounce your last  
8 name?

9 MS. KNOBLAUCH: It's a little bit confusing  
10 because half of my family actually says  
11 Ka-nob-lock; half of my family says Knob-lock.

12 CHAIRMAN BROWN: That's --

13 MS. KNOBLAUCH: So, both are correct.

14 CHAIRMAN BROWN: It's a big difference.

15 MS. KNOBLAUCH: It is.

16 (Laughter.)

17 CHAIRMAN BROWN: So, which half -- is it the  
18 dad's side that says Ka-nob-lock?

19 MS. KNOBLAUCH: My dad's side says Knob-lock.  
20 And then, when my dad got married to my mother,  
21 they started saying Ka-nob-lock.

22 (Laughter.)

23 CHAIRMAN BROWN: That's great. Great story.

24 MS. KNOBLAUCH: Thank you.

25 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Commissioner Patronis, any

1 questions?

2 COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: She got -- she's a  
3 Seminole.

4 CHAIRMAN BROWN: She -- yes. Don't haze her.  
5 She's nice.

6 (Laughter.)

7 Commissioner Brisé.

8 COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Thank you, Madam Chair.  
9 And just on Page 2 of the recommendation, we  
10 see that we have jurisdiction pursuant to  
11 Sections 367.071 and 367.091. What was the context  
12 when those statutes were put into place? Who put  
13 them into place and when?

14 MS. KNOBLAUCH: At the moment, I do not have  
15 that information, but I can certainly get back to  
16 you with an answer.

17 COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Very good answer. Thank  
18 you.

19 MS. KNOBLAUCH: No problem.

20 CHAIRMAN BROWN: That's going to be the  
21 boilerplate answer, I think.

22 (Laughter.)

23 Thank you.

24 Commissioner Polmann.

25 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you, Madam

1 Chairman.

2 I'll just refer to you as Emily, if you don't  
3 mind. And I appreciate your answer to the former  
4 question. And I will forgive you for your  
5 education at FSU.

6 MS. KNOBLAUCH: Thank you.

7 (Laughter.)

8 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. Boom.

9 All right. If there are no real questions of  
10 this item, I am ready to entertain a motion.

11 Commissioner Brisé.

12 COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Madam Chair, move  
13 approval on all issues.
