I am writing in response to the Notice to Customers indicating electricity rates will increase. I would like an explanation of three things:

- 1. While the notice states that the total residential price is <u>lower</u> than it was in 2015, and it will be <u>even lower</u> in January 2017, mainly due to decreased fuel prices, the residential customer's total monthly bill will <u>increase</u> by 6.9 percent. How can that be?
- 2. What causes a kilowatt hour to cost more when delivered to a business as opposed to a residence?
- 3. Why does Gulf Power charge so much more per kilowatt hour than Florida Power?
