

I am legally blind and do not drive. At age 92, my husband is unable to get us to the hearing. A rate increase of the amount proposed will greatly affect our resources. Our cost of living increases were so minimal that they might put a tiny dent in the proposed rate increase.

We are amazed that coal and gas are the primary sources of power while we live in The Sunshine State. Recently the citizens of Florida supported an amendment which would encourage use of solar power. Yet "clean" coal and gas were cited as the primary sources of future power. My father-in-law was a coal miner. Coal is not clean.

Perhaps this letter could help your case in opposing the rate proposal.

- 1. While the notice states that the total residential price is <u>lower</u> than it was in 2015, and it will be <u>even lower</u> in January 2017, mainly due to decreased fuel prices, the residential customer's total monthly bill will <u>increase</u> by 6.9 percent. How can that be?
- 2. What causes a kilowatt hour to cost more when delivered to a business as opposed to a residence?
- 3. Why does Gulf Power charge so much more per kilowatt hour than Florida Power?
