Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Gulf Power Company (GPC) requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information on Document No. 01618-17.

Staff has reviewed GPC's confidentiality request. The document is produced as Schedule No. 2 to Exhibit RMM-3 to the rebuttal testimony of Richard M. Markey which contains confidential information. In staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality due to the information concerning data that would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms set forth in section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. The request also pertains to information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information, and meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that GPC's request for confidentiality in Document No. 01618-17 be approved.
