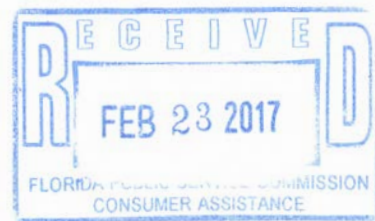

I oppose the increase of rates because:	
I support use of renewables & rewards to those who conserve.

- Young Renters (i.e. college students) have no control on the appliances supplied in rental homes. Shortly after moving into my last rental home, the AC went out. Had to be replaced. Maintenance men told us to keep "fan" setting on unit until they replace the unit. The fan blew 24/7 & cost us double what we pay on average bills. If B48 increase then "emergencies" might be harder to pay.	
- Reason of "smooth plan" - consistent doesn't mean easier to afford or budget.	
- Same Banks who own Southern Company are also funding the unwanted pipelines. I'm not putting more money towards something I disagree with.
